You need to take a course, get some practice and be assessed.

The course

There is a beginner's course for the complete beginner and a C award course for those with some netball experience – for both:

- See you local league umpiring secretary.
- Check out your County website or the Northwest website
- Contact your County Umpiring
- Course is 4-6 hours, cost £25 -£35.

Practice 'makes perfect'!

- At club training
- See you local league umpiring secretary
- Contact your County Umpiring secretary for opportunities to umpire are school's tournament, junior leagues and tournaments or even at County training.

Get assessed

- Contact your County Umpiring secretary to arrange your Test.

Make the Grade!

Now you wish to progress from a C award to B award

You need some experience at C and then you need to take a course, get some practice and be assessed.

The course

- Contact your County or Regional umpiring secretary
- Check out your County website or the Northwest website
- 4-6 hours, cost £37-£45

Practice 'makes perfect'!

- See you local league umpiring secretary
- Contact your County Umpiring secretary for opportunities to umpire are County fixtures, Regional fixtures, County Academy training

Get assessed

- Contact your Regional umpiring secretary who will make the necessary arrangements for assessment and testing.
