

Procedures to become a B Umpire

- 1.** To attend a B Course, you have to be a qualified C Umpire.
- 2.** For dates of a B Course contact the Regional Administrator.
- 3.** Attend a B Course (6 hr session).
- 4.** Gain further Umpiring experience at appropriate level:
 - 1hr matches,
 - Local leagues,
 - County matches,
 - Regional matches.
- 5.** Apply for a pre-assessment via the county Umpiring Secretary (County UMP Sec will appoint 2 testers). The testers will recommend the candidate to either:
 - Improve on identified areas (you will need to re-apply for a pre-assessment in this case),
 - Apply for a test.
- 6.** The test will consist of:
 - A good standard game of 1 hour duration,
 - Oral test.
- 7.** When a candidate is ready to undertake the test, apply for a B Test. Please contact the Regional Administrator for the Application form.
- 8.** Application form and the fee of £20 are to be sent to Officials Officer, who will arrange 2 testers and a fixture. (1 of the tester is to be from a different county other than candidates own.).
- 9.** Officials Officer will send the payment to NW Treasurer.
- 10.** Application will be registered on a database in the order that they are received – first come/first served.
- 11.** Candidates will receive:
 - Confirmation letter,
 - Sample questions.
- 12.** Testers will send the results back to Officials Officer who will then send the results to EN Workforce Development Manager with payment of £5 per test.
- 14.** Treasurer will make a cheque payable to EN Head Office.
- 15.** EN will send the pass cards and badge etc to all successful candidates.
- 16.** Qualified B Umpires will be registered on EN Database.
