

PGL Festival Opportunities

England Netball is working in partnership with PGL to deliver weekend festivals for junior teams in locations across the South West and West Midlands. These are exciting events, which provide competitive opportunities for teams. There are two types of roles we are looking to recruit for, Tournament Organisers and Umpires.

The dates and locations of these festivals are as follows:

- Liddington, Wiltshire – 28th February – 2nd March 2014
- Boreatton Park, Shropshire – 7th – 9th March 2014
- Liddington, Wiltshire – 7th-9th March 2014
- Liddington, Wiltshire – 14th-16th March 2014
- Liddington, Wiltshire – 21st-23rd March 2014
- Liddington, Wiltshire – 28th-30th March 2014

Tournament Organisers:

For this role we are looking for individuals with a minimum of a B award umpiring qualification and experience in tournament organisation and the ability to mentor less experienced umpires.

We will require 1 tournament organiser per event and the responsibilities of this role will include:

- Managing the score table
- Assigning umpires to courts (there will be 3 courts running at once and 9 umpires for each weekend)
- Briefing of umpires
- Briefing players/teams
- Mentoring umpires

Umpires:

For these roles we are looking for individuals who meet one of the following criteria:

- Beginner Award
- Have attended a C award course but are yet to complete the assessment would be considered
- C award umpire
- C award umpire working towards B award
- B award umpire or above able to demonstrate an ability to adapt their umpiring to the level of play on court

These roles will provide an ideal opportunity for practice and development as well as a chance to receive additional umpire mentoring.

We will require 9 umpires for each event and the responsibilities of these roles will include:

- Umpiring matches
- Providing players with rule tips
- Attending an umpire mentoring event on the Saturday night

Further information

Each event will run over a weekend. The Tournament Organiser will be required to arrive on site for 7pm on the Friday evening whereas umpires are required to arrive by 8am on the Saturday and Sunday mornings before the start of play. All staff will be able to leave on the Sunday after the festival is complete. Accommodation on the Friday and Saturday nights (if required) and food between arrival and departure will be provided. Travel expenses will not be reimbursed however Tournament Organisers will receive a flat fee of £175 per festival and Umpires will receive £125 per festival. Individuals will be required to complete delivery for the full event in order to receive payment.

Training

Ideally all Tournament Organisers will need to be available for the first festival on the 28th February – 1st March 2014 as this event will be used for Tournament Organiser training. Those fulfilling umpire roles will not be required to attend any training prior to the event.

*All individuals will be required to be 18 years of age or above at the time of the events
